Lifting Our Community

As Madison's largest African American church, Mount Zion is intentional in its responsibility to "Uplift our Community," an integral part of our mission. Through a host of ministries, community collaborations and partnerships, Mount Zion can extend its reach to thousands annually by offering opportunities and programs designed to assist individuals and families achieve their goal of homeownership, employment, academic achievement, or advocate for health equity in their community. We are continuing to evolve, and that evolution requires additional space designed to grow and address specific and future needs of the surrounding community, creating a cycle of inspiration and energy.

Our current facilities are inadequately equipped to fully address our growth and changing needs. Our facilities have served South Madison for over 110 years but in our effort to meet the need, our facilities have severe age and structural limitations inhibiting our ability to serve a larger community to its fullest potential. By replacing the aging facility with a modern, technologically advanced fully accessible facility, the Family Life Center will increase our ability to expand our capacity to effectively address critical health issues, social challenges, and unmet needs in the surrounding South Madison community. This intentionally designed modern facility allows us to impact four times more lives than are currently served today.

Our New Family Life Center

The Family Life Center will be an accessible, central community space where all – regardless of age, ability, background or income level – can participate, connect, and thrive for generations to come. The Center will be a technologically advanced and energy-efficient facility. The Center will create a community space that impacts thousands of lives where:

- Children develop important life skills and healthy habits, improve academic outcomes, obtain STEM-related training, participate in cultural arts-related activities, and strengthen their potential to become future leaders
- Multi-generations encourage each other in their shared pursuit of healthy living, health equity, chronic disease prevention, and training and development opportunities
- Families have fun, learn, and grow together
- Our South Madison community thrives and grows stronger.










Investing in the Community, Impacting the Lives of Many



We recognize the need for early literacy training, improved high school graduation rates, reduction in youth experiences with the justice system, better health outcomes for seniors, mental health issues, and access to technology and food securities.

- 1. The Food Pantry will have increased storage space and wider community accessibility.
- 2. The Academic Learning Center will provide classrooms, a computer lab, library, and conference rooms.
- 3. The improved and expanded kitchen facilities will enable our Homeless Meal Ministry to prepare more meals and offer on-site services. The commercial kitchen will allow for food preparation training for entrepreneurs.
- 4. The Health and Wellness Center will provide dedicated space for physical & mental wellness, including a gym, walking track, and more space for our Counseling Center.
- 5. The gym space will allow for basketball & volleyball practices, games and tournaments. The space will also be available for community gatherings, conferences, banquets, birthdays, family reunions, funeral gatherings, performances and concerts.
- 6. The Youth Ministry will have a youth center for recreational, educational and support programs.
- 7. The Children's Church Ministry will have more space for its growing attendance.
- 8. The Liturgical Dance Ministry will have access to the Performance Arts Center for dance rehearsals as well as space for other theater and drama performances.
- 9. The Media Studio will serve as the key hub for church media productions, as well as a learning center for photography, video production, and media technology.
- 10. The Center will allow for year-round Senior social activities.

Our Campaign Goal

The estimated cost of the proposed building project is \$10 million. Over the past several years, members have already contributed \$600,000 for the building project. Through this capital campaign, we now seek to raise as much of this project cost as possible. Once it is known what our members will give toward this project, we will be in a better position to continue fundraising from the larger community beyond our congregation. A sound financial plan will be developed prior to moving forward with the project. As always, the congregation will participate in the decision-making each step of the way.

Your Invitation To Give

As you respond to our *Lifting Our Community* Campaign, we ask all of our members and friends to prayerfully consider the following options. We do not want to assume how you might choose to be involved.

Initial Gift – Up front gifts are encouraged, and help us more quickly arrive at that point where construction can begin.

Matching Existing Giving – We ask you to prayerfully consider matching your current regular giving over the next three years. For example, if you are currently giving \$25 per week (\$1,300 a year) to the church's ministry, would you prayerfully consider giving an additional \$25 per week to our *Lifting Our Community* Campaign over the next three years, for a total commitment of \$3,900?

Pacesetter Gift – If you are in a position to give more, we ask you to prayerfully consider making a Pacesetter gift of \$5,000 to \$20,000. Your Pacesetter gift can be given up-front, or over a three year period.

Legacy Gift – We invite those who have been financially blessed to prayerfully consider making a Legacy gift of \$20,000 to \$100,000 or more.
